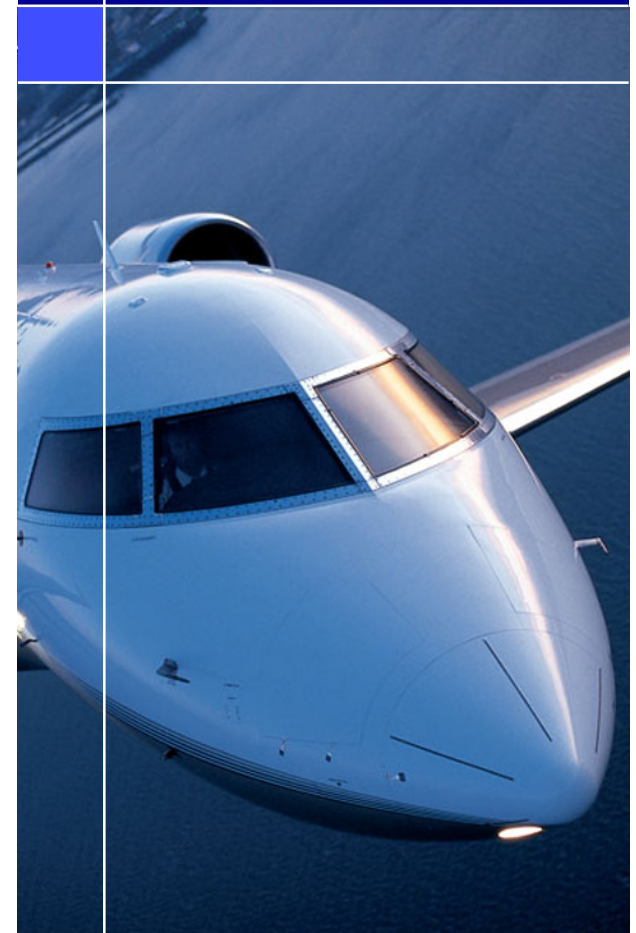

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Is there any age limit in participating the Commercial Pilot License program?

The minimum FAA requirement is 17 years of age and you can continue to fly for as long as you meet the license renewal requirements.

2. Is the CPL recognized in China?

Yes, FAA license is the one foreign pilot license being most recognized by the Civil Aviation of China.

3. Can I get employment for Airlines in China with the CPL?

Technically speaking yes, and you may need further training depending on what aircraft you are hired to operate since every aircraft is different.

4. How long does it take to complete the program?

6 months.

5. Does JetOne Academy provide housing and local transportation?

Yes, we will make arrangement for housing nearby the school and also local transportation that takes you between your living quarters and school. Airport pickup is also a complimentary service on JetOne Academy.

Commercial Pilot License Program

The professional pilot program is designed to take you from zero time to commercial pilot multi engine in 6 months time. It will provide all the necessary qualifications for a career in aviation. Upon obtaining the CPL certification, you will be able to receive payment for your pilot services. Airline companies look for a combination of certification when hiring. The standard order to the licenses and ratings is as follow:

A. Private Pilot - (35 – 40 flight hours minimum required by FAA under Part 141) This is always the first part of your commercial training. Private pilot training is where you will begin obtaining your pilot skills and building your career in aviation.

B. Instrument Rating - (40-50 flight hours minimum required by FAA under Part 141) The Instrument Rating is the next step in your flight training. This rating

enables you to fly in less-than-perfect skies by using the instruments in the cockpit panel.

C. Commercial Pilot - (190 flight hours minimum required by FAA under Part 141) You will be trained to stricter commercial standards and more flying will be accomplished. Our Commercial Pilot Program is an accelerated, structured program that allows you to obtain the necessary flight training to be able to transition to a commercial pilot position.
